# Why Back on Track?

- Over 800 young Australians are diagnosed with cancer each year.
- Most will receive chemotherapy and/or radiation therapy.
- Some will receive bone marrow and stem cell transplants.
- Many will require extended absences from school, up to three years, leading to educational disadvantage and social isolation.
- Not uncommon for these young people to ‘fall by the wayside’

# How Back on Track Works

- Creates the means for schools, teachers, patients and peer groups to remain connected through ‘virtual classrooms’ and the internet.
- Education Advisors create tailored learning programs taking into account medical condition, also provide one-on-one tutoring at hospital, home and special accommodation centres.
- Facilitates continued social development.
- Mentoring program.
- Psychological support program.
- Work experience and placement program.
